

Guidelines for Authors

General information

Moscow University Soil Science Bulletin is a scientific peer-reviewed journal that has been published in a separate series since 1977. The periodicity of the publication is 4 issues per year.

The journal publishes original articles and reviews on all fundamental and applied aspects of soil science. The editorial policy of the journal is aimed at presenting current research related to the understanding of the ecological functions of soils, as well as biological, chemical, and physical processes and interactions in soils, as widely as possible by subject and geographical scope.

The Editorial Board of the "Soil Science Bulletin of Moscow University" carries out its activities in accordance with the recommendations of the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE). The editorial board of the journal uses the principle of double-blind peer review. External and internal experts specializing in the subject of the article are involved in the review process.

The [English version](#) of the journal is prepared by the group of publishers Pleiades Publishing and distributed by [Springer](#).

Pleiades Publishing also forms the 5th additional issue of the journal in English.

Only new articles, unpublished earlier or not sent to other print or online editions, are accepted for publication in the journal. The editorial board checks articles in the «Antiplagiat» system. Scientific misconduct, including plagiarism, self-plagiarism, borrowing without permission are not allowed. Quotes can only be provided in the original language with a mandatory link.

A Copyright Agreement is obligatory concluded with the authors. By signing the agreement, the authors confirm that the article contains original materials.

Articles submitting

Articles are submitted by the e-mail of the Editorial Office in Microsoft Word 97-2003 and higher version (*.doc, *.docx, *.rtf) using a special template.

The volume of the manuscript submitted to issues 1-4 should not exceed 5000 words including the list of references. There is no limitation on the volume of articles submitted to the 5th issue. Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1,5 spacing, indent 1,25 cm, margins of 25 mm and full justified should be used.

Please follow the Pleiades Publishing [Guidelines for typesetting](#).

For verification of characters that may be displayed incorrectly, it is recommended to attach a PDF file with text and illustrations. The file should be named after the author's surname, and if there are several authors — by the surname of the first one (for example, Ivanov et al.doc, Ivanov et al.pdf).

The editorial board reserves the right not to consider articles prepared without regarding these rules.

Article structure

Research papers should be structured and include the sections below.

TITLE

AUTHORS & AFFILIATIONS

ABSTRACT (the volume of 200 to 350 words is intended to serve as the main source of information about the article)

KEY WORDS (3–7 words and/or short phrases) should reflect the main content of the article, not repeat the terms of the title

INTRODUCTION

MATERIALS AND METHODS

RESULTS

DISCUSSION CONCLUSIONS

FUNDING

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

COMPLIANCE WITH ETHICAL STANDARDS

REFERENCES

The list of references has to be written in alphabetical order.

Links in the text area are written in square brackets [], indicating the author's surname and year of issue. For example [Dale, 1978]. If there are two authors - specify them separated by commas [Rosenkranz, Chamy, 2013]. If there are more than two authors - indicate the first author and «et al.» [Smagin et al., 2018].

The last page contains **information about the authors**: scientific degree, position, place of work, e-mail.

Tables and Figures

The total number of tables and figures should be no more than 7-10 units for the manuscript submitted in issues 1-4. Illustrations and tables can be both black and white and *color*. Captions to drawings and photographs containing the decoding of symbols are given not on the illustrations themselves, but separately in the text.

Figures and tables are inserted into the main text immediately after they are mentioned. In addition, all illustrations must be provided in separate files. Figures designed in Microsoft Excel are provided in *.xls or *.xlsx format, figures made in other programs and photographs are provided in TIFF format. The pixel resolution of images must ensure that all details are clear (at least 300 dpi).

Preparing to print

Peer-reviewed manuscript is sent to the authors for correction. The corrected version of the article must be returned to the editorial office in 7 days, along with a detailed answer to all comments. If the corrected version is sent back later than 7 days period, the article is considered as newly submitted.

Cover letter

By submitting articles for publication in this journal, the authors agree that:

1. This article has not been previously published, nor has it been submitted for review or publication in another journal.
2. The article has not been produced by artificial intelligence (AI) programs. If AI has been used at any stage of producing the paper, the authors should clearly state the extent of the use of AI and guarantee that the final version has been revised and reworked by the authors.
3. The authors do not intend to advertise, promote or discredit any persons, institutions or commercial products.
